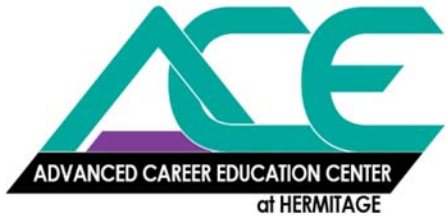

APPLYING TO ACE CENTERS

INFORMATION FOR THE 8TH GRADE STUDENT



Using the online application, apply in 8th grade for the cluster areas of your choice (see back). The application will be located at <http://henricoschools.us/specialty-centers/> under the ACE Center tab for 8th grade students. The application process will be open from November 20th until January 12th. Once the application has been completed, submit the application.

March 24-30, 2018: Summer Polytech registration for 8th grade students accepted and who intend to attend the ACE Centers

Students who apply to the ACE Centers will take classes at their zoned high school during the Freshman and Sophomore years. In December of the Sophomore year, accepted students will select the course in which they will enroll for the Junior and Senior years. The ACE Center programs are half-day programs to which the students are transported by Henrico County Public Schools.

During the Freshman and Sophomore years, students will meet with the ACE Center School Counselors and the ACE Center teachers to explore the courses that are available in the cluster areas to which they applied. Students will also attend events and programs related to those cluster areas during Freshman and Sophomore years. This will include activities at the ACE Centers, visits to the zoned high schools and summer activities and programs. In the spring or summer before Junior year, students will complete necessary placement testing for dual enrollment courses.
